Vets Returning Home is the only facility of it's kind in Macomb County. Our program development includes ongoing research of current Michigan program features, implementation of hands on accountability to ensure that our vets obtain what is promised them, and ongoing vision to improve and simplify program features going into the future. Our structured programs provide: Life Skills Training, Employment Training, Education, Job Opportunities/Referrals, and Health Care Screening, Benefits and Entitlements Assistance. Vets Returning Home works closely with a multitude of human service providers, nonprofit organizations and government agencies to meet the needs of the veteran's medical, psychological and educational needs. The purpose of our program is to give support to our veterans, who risked their lives for our country.

Vietnam Veterans Association Chapter 154 runs a veteran's food pantry. From its early beginnings as a few food items stored under the stairway of a member's home, our food pantry has grown to now feature approximately 1,200 square feet of storage space for canned and dry goods, and now includes a walk-in refrigerator/freezer for cold item and meat storage. Our food pantry is inspected and certified for safe food handling by the Macomb County Food Bank as well as one of our providers, Forgotten Harvest. In recent years we have been assisting about 800 veterans each year that walk through our doors and, factoring in the sizes of their families, we are feeding about 2,500 people annually.
